Project Title: Library Literacy Program

Project Date: School Year 2017-2018

Briefly describe the project. What was done and who were the beneficiaries?

The project’s aim was to engage parents and children at the Dual Immersion Academy (DIA) in Glendale, Salt Lake City to enhance literacy in homes took on a different approach in order to involve families. The Utah State Office of Education classifies DIA as a “turn-around” school. It had serious deficiencies in reading and math for a segment of its school populations. The state devoted additional staff to enhance its reading program through using volunteer reading tutors, parent tutors, and classroom-integrated programs. The state-developed packages involve 26 levels of high interest books already purchased by DIA. The \$300 grant was applied to supplies needed for classrooms and volunteers. Three of our club members tutored students 2x a week since March of 2016 after the tutors attended a training program led by the school’s Executive Director, the School Principal, and the Director of Response to Intervention. The program will be continued next year. Our club will hopefully provide funding for more tutors next year. We have started implementing plans with the SLCC Director of Academic and Career Advising to recruit students as tutors in the fall.

Give an example of how Rotarians participated:

Three tutors have participated three months, 2x/week, with two critical 3rd grade students each in a structured reading program designed by the state to be delivered by volunteer tutors (STAR Reading Program). Snacks were donated by Rotarians for the reading sessions. IMPACT: Parents have asked our members if they could also learn to read English.
